

CITY OF SEERS

Didim, one of 12 Ionian cities, Miletos took its place in the stage of history as "Sacred City" or "Worship Place" under the name of Didyma. This geography being home to Ionians, Persians, Seleucid, Pergamons, Romans, Byzantines and Turks witnesses countless historical events and culture.
