Kirazli Village



The rest of the road will direct you to spectacular Kusadasi beach. There the symbol and talisman of Guvercinada is right in front of you! The thin and long jetty connecting the island to beach resembles a movie scene with its castle built on rocks.

This little rocky island in the shape of bean having a castle dated to 16th century is connected to mainland by a thin and narrow road. The island fortified by ramparts during Ottoman period had been used for military purposes such as defense and observation.
